Doctoral Program

The Graduate Institute of Landscape Architecture was established in 1991. It offers the M.L.A. degree in Landscape Architecture. The aims of the Institute are:

- 1.to Cultivate high-level landscape research and to provide professional training for Landscape Architects.
- 2.to fulfill the needs of national construction development projects.

The objectives of the program are:

- 1.to develop the students’ professional competence and training in dealing with tasks beneficial to social change.
- 2.to emphasize studies of landscape in human and natural aspects.(Based on a social and ecological approach).
- 3.to support the development of Landscape Architecture research, project design and education.

Program of Study:

The program consists of two areas from which the students may choose. The first is professional training, emphasizing the development of skills in design, especially urban landscape and open space planning and design. The second emphasizes research, with particular focus on recreational theory, and landscape ecological theory, the choice based on the student’s own interests and advice from faculty.
